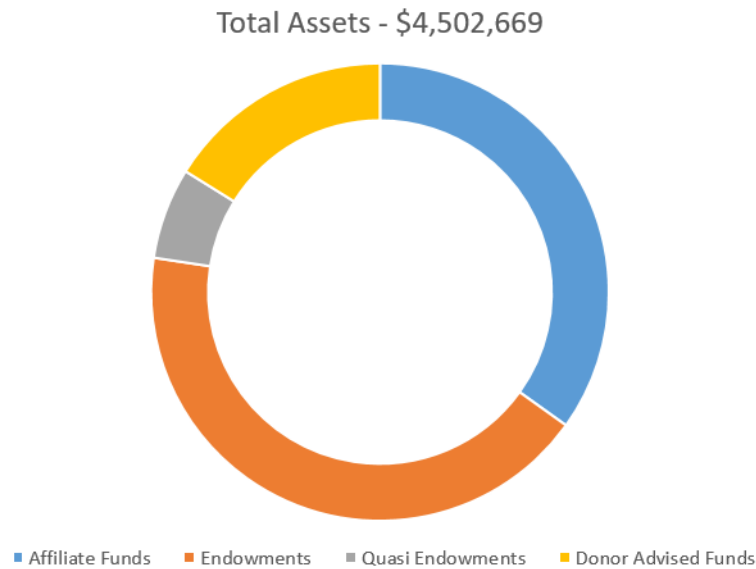

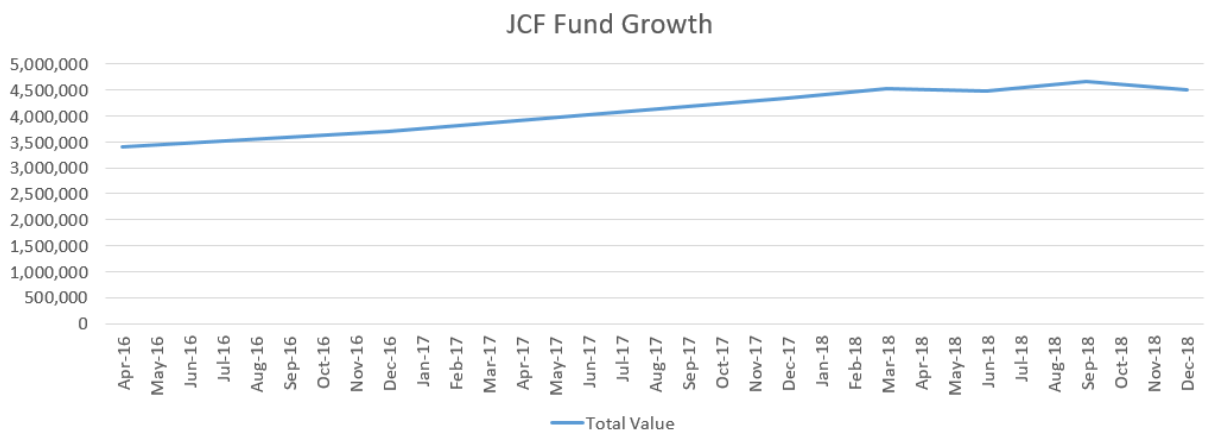
2018 Yearend Foundation Financial Summary
